State Charity Update – Eagles Funds to Help Construct Clinic at ChildServe

Resources generated from this year's Fraternal Order of Eagles fundraising efforts will help expand programs to serve children with special healthcare needs at ChildServe.

Funds will be directed to construct a Complex Behavioral Health Clinic that will serve children with autism and autism spectrum-related conditions and children who have a dual diagnosis that includes a disability/ developmental delay along with a behavioral health condition.

ChildServe has experienced a rising trend in the number of children with these complex conditions, and this new space will allow additional children to receive these much-needed services. It is anticipated that 750 children will receive services in the Complex Behavioral Health Clinic by the program's third year; and more than 1,000 annually when full capacity is reached.

Gifts from the Eagles state charity will combine with other contributions to help construct the clinic. About 2,500 square feet on the first floor of the ChildServe Center in Johnston will be repurposed to create a space where clinicians, children and families can come together and services can be delivered. The floorplan includes four rehab treatment rooms, a play area, offices, a rehab tech work area, and six multipurpose treatment rooms.

The scope of this initiative also includes organizational investment in licensed clinicians and professionals such as mental health therapists, certified behavioral analysts, child psychologists and psychiatric nurse practitioners. The program will serve children who have autism and related conditions, childhood behavioral conditions to include anxiety disorder, depression, separation anxiety, oppositional defiance, reactive attachment, and attentiondeficit/hyperactivity disorder.

Now in its 90th year of operation, ChildServe improves the health and development of children who have a disability, developmental delay, acquired injury or chronic medical condition. ChildServe is Iowa's only comprehensive inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation medicine program designed exclusively for children, and provided care to 4,235 children in 2017.
