Knuckleheads Notes



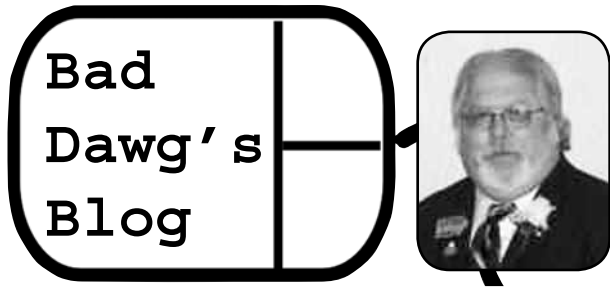
What a winter we've had. But it's almost time to start thinking about the beach and surfing and all the great stuff that us beach bums do.
