

Are You In Compliance?

Dear Auxiliary Sisters:

The Compliance Department at the Grand Aerie is working to get us all within the requirements of the Ladies Auxiliary Rules and Regulations. Here are just a few things that you need to check on to be sure you are moving in the right direction.

1. 2012 Version of the Affiliation Agreement. You should have a copy of this on file in the Secretary's office. If you do not know, please contact the Rhonda at the Grand Aerie to be sure.

2. Your Officer's are bonded or you have current Director and Officer's insurance.

3. General Liability Insurance with the Grand Aerie of the Fraternal Order of Eagles named additionally insured. Work with your Aerie to be on the same policy as they have. Usually there is no additional cost in adding the Auxiliary as a named insured to the Aerie's policy.

4. Per capita and fees are paid current

5. Your 990 taxes are filed by October 15 or you have filed an extension. Please forward a copy to the Grand Aerie.

Take the time to research whether these 5 requirements have been met. It's not only important to your Auxiliary, but to all the Aerie and Auxiliaries across the jurisdiction. Don't be the weakest link!






Shouts from the Sidewinder


